KnitCrosheen, #2 needles (15")

The number in ( ) at the end of each round indicates the number of sts in a pattern repeat. The pattern unit is repeated 8 times per round unless otherwise noted.

Cast on 8 sts and divide to DP needles.

Rnd 1 KB in each st.

Rnd 2 O, K1. (2)

Rnd 3 O, K2. (3)

Rnd 4 O, K3. (4)

Rnd 5 O, K2, K2 tog. (4)

Rnd 6 O, K4. (5)

Rnd 7 O, K3, K2 tog. (5)

Rnd 8 O, K5. (6)

Rnd 9 O, K4, K2 tog. (6)

Rnd 10 O, K6. (7)

Rnd 11 O, K5, K2 tog. (7)

Rnd 12 O, K7. (8)

Rnd 13 O, K6, K2 tog. (8)

Rnd 14 O, K8. (9)

Rnd 15 O, K7, K2 tog. (9)

Rnd 16 O, K9. (10)

Rnd 17 O, K8, K2 tog. (10)

Rnd 18 O, K10. (11)

Rnd 19 O, K9, K2 tog. (11)

Rnd 20 O, K11. (12)

Rnd 21 S(1)RHN: \*K12, O. (13)

Rnd 22 SKP, K1, CT 3 as follows (using a 5th needle at back of work, K3 sts onto it.

Wrap thread tightly around all 3 sts 4 times. Thread should end at back.

Transfer 3 sts to right needle and continue), K7, O. (13)

Rnd 23 K13, O. (14)

Rnd 24 SKP, K3, CT 3, K6, O. (14)

Rnd 25 K14, O. (15)

Rnd 26 SKP, K5, CT 3, K5, O. (15)

Rnd 27 K15, O. (16)

Rnd 28 SKP, K7, CT 3, K4, O. (16)

Rnd 29 K16, O. (17)

Rnd 30 SKP, K9, CT 3, K1, K2 tog, O. (16)

Rnd 31 K15, O, K1, O. (18)

Rnd 32 SKP, K5, CT 3, K3, K2 tog, O, K3, O. (18)

Rnd 33 K13, O, K5, O. (20)

Rnd 34 SKP, K1, CT 3, K5, K2 tog, O, K2, CT 3, K2, O. (20)  
Rnd 35 K11, O, K9, O. (22)  
Rnd 36 SKP, K7, K2 tog, O, K11, O. (22)  
Rnd 37 K9, O, K2, CT 3, K3, CT 3, K2, O. (24)  
Rnd 38 SKP, K5, K2 tog, O, K6, O, CT 3, O, K6, O. (26)  
Rnd 39 SKP, K3, K2 tog, O, K4, O, K3, O, K5, O, K3, O, K4, O. (30)  
Rnd 40 SKP, K1, K2 tog, O, K2, CT 3, (O, K5) 3 times, O, CT 3, K2, O. (34)  
Rnd 41 S2KP, O, K31, O. (34)  
Rnd 42 K1, O, K7, O, CT 3, O, K2, O, CT 3, O, K3, O, CT 3, O, K2, O, CT 3, O, K7, O.  
(44)  
Rnd 43 Knit.  
Rnd 44 S(2)RHN: \*O, K1, CT 3, O, S2KP, O, K5, O, S2KP, O, K3, O, K5, O, K3, O,  
S2KP, O, K5, O, S2KP, O, CT 3, K1, O, S2KP. (46)  
Rnd 45 Knit.  
Rnd 46 K21, O, CT 3, O, K22. (48)  
Rnd 47 (K11, O, K7, O) twice, K12. (52)  
Rnd 48 S(2)RHN: \*K6, O, S2KP, O, K5, O, S2KP, O, K13, O, S2KP, O, K5, O, S2KP,  
O, K6, K5 tog as follows: (K2 tog, K3 tog, pass the K2 tog st over the K3 tog st).

Rnd 49 S(1)RHN: \*K5 tog, K35, K5 tog, S2KP. (38)  
Rnd 50 S(1)RHN: \*K4, (O, S2KP, O, K5) 3 times, O, S2KP, O, K7. (38)  
Rnd 51 K5, O, K1, O, K7, O, K4, O, K1, O, K4, O, K7, O, K1, O, K8. (46)

*Edging:* With crochet hook, (pick up 1 st, sc) 5 times, \*(ch 6, pick up 3 sts, sc) 11 times, ch 6, (pick up 1 st, sc) 13 times. Repeat from \* around, ending with 1 sc in each of next 8 sts. Sl st in beginning sc. Fasten off.

## TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** - chain

**CT** - cluster tie: Knit the designated number of stitches to an extra double-pointed needle and hold the needle in back of work. With a counter-clockwise motion, wrap thread 4 times around these stitches, pulling snugly. Slip the ties stitches onto the right-hand needle.

**DP** - double pointed needles

**K** - knit

**KB** - knit 1 in the back loop of the next stitch

**K2 tog** - knit 2 together

**O** - yarn over

**Rnd** – round

**S(1)RHN** - slip 1 stitch to the right hand needle [or slip the number of stitches in the ( )'s]. Move your marker to this new location to indicate that the first stitch on the left needle is now the beginning of the pattern unit. Adjust all markers in the round as you come to them.

**SKP** - Slip 1 stitch, knit 1 stitch and pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch

**S2KP** - Slip 2 stitches, knit 1 stitch and pass the slipped stitches over the knit stitch

**sc** - single crochet

**sl** - slip

**tog** – together
